Tom talked about the final remote ID rule that was recently released. There are 3 ways to comply which we don't have to be in compliance for almost 3 years.

1.) Transponder built in
- Mainly for commercial or autonomous vehicles

2.) Be a designated a FRIA (FAA recognized Identification area) This one will apply to us, it means we get designated a FRIA and continue as we have. Register with the FAA every 3 years for 1 number for all your planes. (see Jan newsletter for more info)

3.) Flying outside a FRIA will require a broadcast module - should be movable from plane to plane and cost from \$20 to

\$50

Float fly's - apply for a 1 time "sanction"
