- 1 How is this set up, do you have and airfield / runway you plan to mow down for a grass strip?
- 2 Are your planes gas or electric?
- 3 Can you provide a general process, schedule and procedure?
- 4 Can we fly our own planes?

5 You mention housing but many of us have motorhomes and/or campers we take to events or if we're spending several days flying somewhere. Are there accommodations to park a camper during the stay?

Hey Jim. I'd be happy to answer some of the questions.

We fly out on the farm, so we use whatever landing surface we can find. Usually dirt/gravel roads.

All our planes are electric. We use the horizon hobby Turbo Timber. Each pilot is given two airplanes and 12 batteries.

#### SUMMER RC FLYING JOB

We want everyone to use our planes and equipment unless you have the same planes we do. We want uniformity.

We have a morning shift and an afternoon shift. We do our best to work schedules with everyone. We would like people to commit to the full 1 month of flying, but we can make accommodations if necessary. Shifts are 6 hours. We only fly when the birds are present. There is often a lot of down time as the birds don't always hit at the same time. During the heart of harvest, it gets busier with the birds and flying is more consistent.

As for Motorhomes/RVs, we would cover the costs of an RV park here in Yakima. For those that don't have RVs, we pay for a hotel room. We do share rooms, so it's two people


