WINTER BUILD PROJECT

My winter build project is finally making some progress again. I ordered some Stits lite covering and have gotten the wings covered with help from Jack Mitchell.

It's a 3 step process which involves:

1 - gluing the fabric down and tightening it with a covering iron. The fabric shrinks 10 - 12% so it easy to get the wrinkles out.

2 - Filling the weave with poly brush. You paint it on with a brush over the cloth where it touches the wood and spray it on over the cloth that doesn't.

3 - Painting, this involves painting a silver primer coat that prevents light from showing through and then painting the color on.

All the chemicals in this process are solvent based and 75% of the weight you spray on evaporates.

You use:

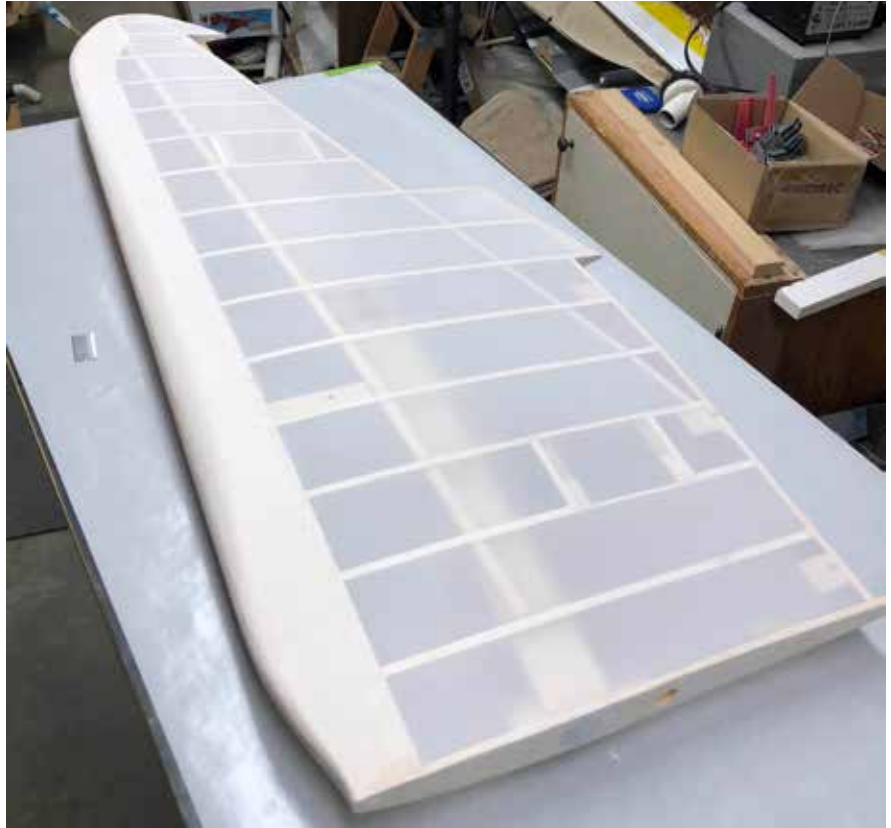
Poly tak - the glue

Poly brush - to fill the weave

Poly spray - to block transparency

Poly tone - to apply color

MEK - as a thinner and cleaner.
