Paul Flemming gave a short talk on the upcoming scale qualifier and what it takes to be a judge. Bob Bailey is going to be the CD for the scale qualifier to replace Tom Sr.. Tom Jr. is willing to take his place as Event director if needed. The judging clinic is going to be on Saturday April 18th from 12:00 to 2:00ish, we've decided to have a club fly-in from 8:00 to 12:00 and maybe more flying after the clinic. This first fly-in will be a bring your own lunch kind of a thing with the usual potluck coming later in the year. If the 18th gets sold we will move to hunter farms.

Jody Diaz talked about Aviation days: We have heard back from the sponsors, do we want to participate. Bob Beatty checked with the Port about the runway use on that day and the car club has it rented so we will be unable to have flying demos. We will keep tabs on it.

The survey only netted 17 responses, not even 50%.

We've informed the boat club (John and Bob) that we wanted to use the crab sandwich machine. We need to find out when we can register for Oysterfest. We also need to line up people with food handlers licenses. We need one per shift. A committee was formed with Sharon Diaz as chair and John Tupper, Bob Trienen and Mike Jones as committee members.
