TIPS AND TRICKS

I accidentally left my transmitter on and found the battery dead. When I attempted to charge it, I got an error message that the voltage was too low: two of the cells were, in fact, below 2 volts. After searching the Web for a solution, I ended up removing the balance connector from my charger and charging the LIPO as a NIMH for about 10 minutes at .8A. I was then able to charge the LIPO normally. by Royce Tivel
