We will have a maiden flight fly-in. The aircraft must take off, make at least one lap and land. If you are not comfortable flying your plane, you can have someone else fly it for you.

Here are the build challenge rules! Remember to post your picture in the Sanderson Field R/C Flyers google group.

Here are the rules:

1. Must be a new build

from a balsa kit. No repair jobs of previously flown aircraft.

2. Must post at least one pic of the build in the R/C Flyers Google Group, and must be a current picture.

3. No ARF's or Foamies.

4. Previously started kits ok, but must be less than 50% completed/not covered when picture is posted.

5. Can be any size or type of kit (lock/tab, die cut, scratch built)

6. Can be glow, gas or electric

7. Open to any AMA club member

8. Must be completed prior to AND flown at maiden party
