starting the afternoon of July 13th after 2 pm

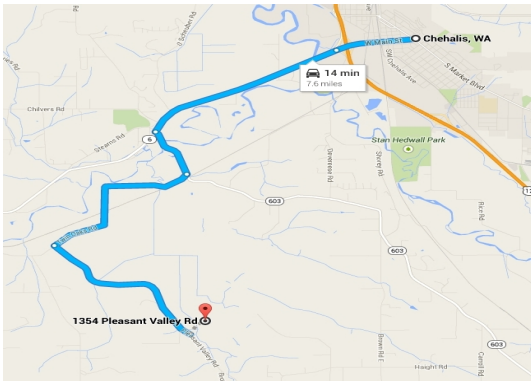

We love big planes but bring any size of plane you have. We don't discriminate. We just want to see you there.

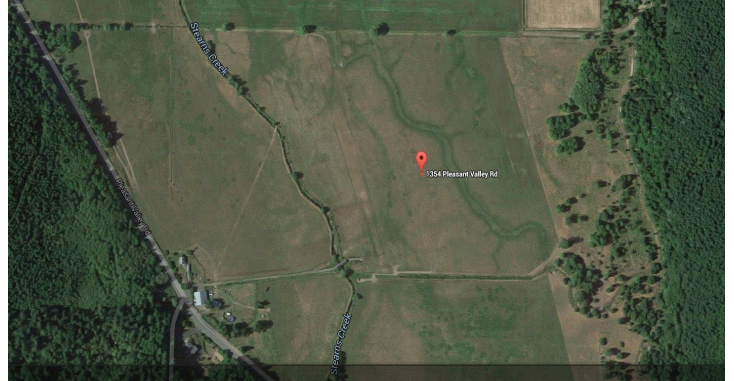
Place
