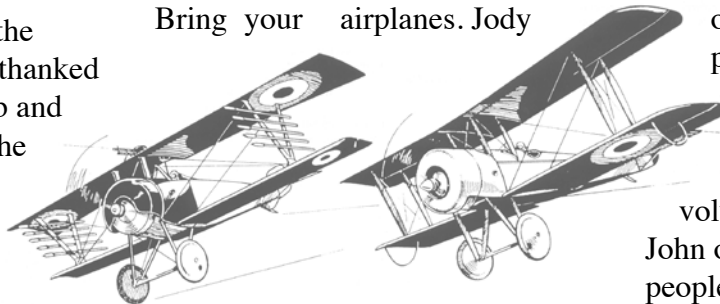

He gets about 5 ton an acre per year. We will only need a little less than 1/2 acre which would be about \$700 per year. We now need to decide if

we want to have a secondary field with the increased cost to the club. A letter will be sent out to inform the membership. The field would be usable around 6 months of the year.

John Tupper mentioned another possible site at Joe Burgault's farm.

The 24th of May we will meet at Jody and Sharon's place to work on the parade float. Bring your airplanes. Jody



showed the new banner's for the float that Darryl's nephew made for us.

who manned the course for the last pylon race.

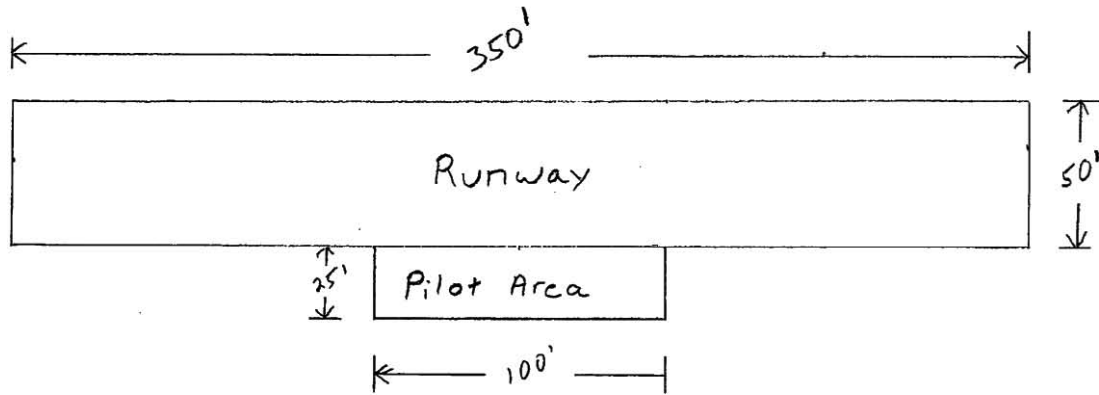
Dick showed his new model Daletel Viking.

1. Head South on I-5
2. Take Exit 104, this merges onto US 101
3. Take Exit to Shelton, Belfair (State Route 3) its the next exit after Mudd Bay Rd.
4. Continue on 101 past Shelton, about 8 miles
5. Turn Right onto E Purdy Cutoff Rd. for 3 miles until stop sign.
6. Across from stop sign is Hunter Farms, turn Left on 106 and then immediate Right into the parking lot. Once in the parking lot , stay left and look for a road going towards the fields.
