WEIGHT LIFT CHALLENGE

At the AMA jamboree 3 clubs who are already doing a winter build challenge were presented with a mini Apprentice electric airplane (one of which was SFRCF) and informed that a contest would be held in conjunction with next years winter build challenge. No details were given at the time but have since been provided...

Attention All District 11 Clubs! I have a Challenge for you. Ready to test your mettle against other clubs to see who's best? Winter build Mini-Apprentice Weightlifting Challenge Must use a Mini- Apprentice RTF from Horizon hobby. All stock electronics, flight stabilization system, radio, battery, ESC, Prop, and servos must be used from the kit.

Fuselage must remain unchanged except for the following mods: Change Wheels You can add a cargo pod or weight box and attach to fuselage, no other mods to fuselage.

Allowed Modifications: You can change the wing, tail, and horizontal stabilizer however you like.

Again: You can change the wheels.

You can add a weight holding pod to the belly of the fuselage, or under wings For Flight: Aircraft must Rise off ground under it's own power, unassisted in any way. IE no pushing, bungee, rocket assist etc.

You must make an unedited video showing the scale set to zero, and then adding the aircraft to the scale. (can use a piece of foam or similar to support the full weight of aircraft hands free, but scale must show zeroed with this foam/ support, minus the aircraft)

Video must show the empty weight on the scale ready to fly with battery, followed by a take-off, fly the pattern, and successful landing with minimum of 1 minute flight time in the empty configuration.

Followed immediately by Then showing of load the aircraft with weight, and show the unedited video of adding weight, weight on the scale, followed by successful take-off, pattern, landing with a minimum of 1 minute flight time at full lifting weight.

Both empty and loaded flights must be same day, within an hour of each other. You may make numerous flights to increase weight carrying, or new design changes within the period of 1 June 2019, and 30 May 2020. You may submit as many videos as you like to the AMA District Facebook page.

You also must show pictures either via Dropbox, or on Facebook club pages, or the AMA District Facebook page showing your builds, and videos. This will prove your work, show the team involved with the build etc.

If your team has at least 1 under 18 member of the build and flying, you can add ½ ounce of weight to your flying total weight.

Must have plenty of documentation showing an under 18 was involved with the build and or flying. Video is even better!!

WHAT WILL THE WINNING TEAM RECEIVE? Up to 5 adult members- AMA dues paid for by the District for 2021, and their respective club will get their dues paid for by the District for 2021! Under 19 receives free AMA anyway.

So...what are you waiting for? Let the building begin!! And most of all, have fun, and bring a kid along for the ride!
