The Viper club guys were already there to set up for their weekend event. They set up the North end and waited for us to be done.

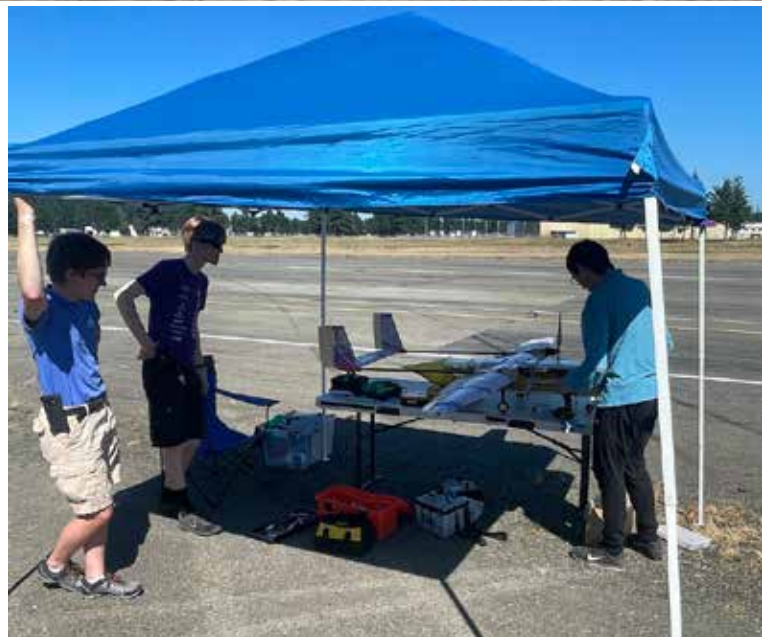
Hunters had a big tractor with a disc on it Paul had to work around but it turned out great! (sorry blackberry pickers)
