

The status for your FAA-Recognized Identification Area (FRIA) application 2023-CBO-00414-FRIA - Sanderson Field RC Flyers #3079 - Shelton Airport has been updated.

FRIA Application Status: Denied

Reason/Justification: This application is denied for the following reason:

The request submitted is in the proximity of an airport, Sanderson Field (KSHN). 14 CFR § 89.215(b), AC 89-3 Section 7.3.1. The requested FRIA area poses an unacceptable risk to the safe and efficient use of the airspace near other airport(s). When aircraft are operating close to the ground, the potential for interactions between UA and other aircraft increases, as does the severity of potential consequences from failing to comply with applicable operating rules. Reference: § 89.215(b), AC 89-3 Section 7.3.1.

Bad news first I guess, our FRIA application has been denied. (Ashton is the AMA representative who submitted the application)

I have sent the denial to our District VP and have been in contact with Ashton at the AMA and they are working to see if there is a work around. We only have 1 more month at this point before we must have a remote ID module in our airplanes. Right now the only ones available are around \$300 but the District VP assured us at the Jamboree that there would be cheaper ones available before the deadline.

In light of our FRIA denial, and in case our appeal is also denied. Here is a remote Id module that is only \$109 as apposed to the \$300 modules. Deadline for compliance is September 16th.

EZ ID is Here!

From Flite Test...

The Flite Test EZ ID which will be available in production volumes in August of 2023. In addition, the FPV Freedom Coalition provided advice on FAA remote ID regulations as well as product management experience to the development effort. The FT EZ ID's FAA Declaration of Compliance was approved by the FAA in May 2023. The FT EZ ID complies with the FAA's Remote ID Means of Compliance which means it complies with both the ASTM F3411 and F3586 standards on remote ID.

The FT EZ ID weighs only 10 grams, less than one-third of an ounce, can be powered by 2S to 8S batteries, and provides an integrated GPS receiver and a Bluetooth transmitter with antennas etched on the printed circuit board, reducing the total weight and functions without any external antennas hanging off the aircraft. The average power draw of the FT EZ ID is a low 10 milliamps meaning there will be a small power penalty when using the FT EZ ID on radio control fixed wing or multirotor aircraft. The price of the FT EZ ID will have a manufacturer's suggested retail price of \$109 and will be available for sale from the Flite Test store at https://store.flitetest.com/, GetFPV at https://www.getfpv.com and other online retail sites.




SFRCF Hunter Farms Field Union Washington
