#### CLUB MEMBER PROJECT

Club member Royce Tivel is working on a Balsa USA laker sea plane, he has supplied some pics. Looking good Royce!

I applied the first trim to the Laker. First, I lightly wet sanded the surface with 320 paper. Next, I used Frog Tape to mask the trim and then newspaper and blue tape to protect the rest of the fuselage. I applied the first thin coat of white and then, per the instructions on the can, applied a second coat after waiting a few minutes. Also, per the Frog Tape instructions, I immediately removed the tape. As the images show, this is not a perfect job but fits into my goal of a 30 foot finish: looks good at 30 feet. All in all, I am satisfied with the results. After all the trim is done, I plan to add a coat of clear to protect the finish and add some gloss.


