As of this writing our FRIA application has been resubmitted with extra wording and a copy of our lease agreement with the Port of Shelton. Everyone I've talked to seems to think it will be approved this time.

I'd like to remind everyone our lease agreement with the Port requires us to follow all state and federal laws.

Right now only Spektrum has a FAA approved module available for pre order under \$100. Right now a pre order is \$30 off. I don't see anything on the Flitetest website though they claim they'll have one for \$109.
