Top Flite Stinson Reliant with Fiberglass specialty parts

I wasn't planning on another scale airplane for winter build next year but this one was given to me by a friend who had it given to him and I couldn't resist the challenge.

The Giant scale Stinson Reliant came with all the Fiberglass specialty parts, a cockpit kit and a dummy radial. It has a 100" wingspan and will require a 35CC gas motor. It will probably weigh 20-25lbs. The kit is missing the landing gear, which might be a little bit of a challenge since the kit is no longer available.

When I opened the box I found a whole bunch of wood and not many die cut sheets, you even have to build the formers for the fuselage.




