Meeting was called to order at
7:15pm

September meeting minutes were read, and accepted as read.

Treasury report was read and accepted as read.

Also let the club now the NMPRA would like to be back in 2017. Tom Strom Jr. read some comments from the racers that attended that had been posted in online forums. Total income for the club from the race was \$1,356.93.
