Stacy Myers motioned to do Oysterfest annually. Motion carried. Tom Jr. motioned we purchase the sandwich machine from the dive club for a competitive price, motion carried.

Some of the ideas to improve the Oysterfest process are: Reduce the number of simulators

and use it for training.

Use timers to limit time on the simulators,

Use both tents for the display booth.

Make up a poster for initial costs of getting into RC.

Make up a bread board of an airplane to help explain the workings of RC.

Shorten the shifts to spread the work.

Have a better variety of airplanes at the display booth.

Have an orientation before Oysterfest for training purposes.

Marc Winz motioned to reimbursed Dick Robb \$523 for table rental for the swap meet. Dick Robb also mentioned that 70% of the tables have been sold and that if you want a table you had better not wait till the last minute.

No new officer nominations, Stacy Myers motioned to continue with current officers. Motion seconded and passed.


