They use chain to tension the string and also slow the plane down. Paul Fleming can 3d print carrier hooks if that's something you are interested in. Some of the other events

were:

Carrier landing, catch the 3rd wire for the best score

Precision landing which is like the carrier landing with out the hook.

Combat with 30' long streamers.

Formation flying.

Bomb drop, there is a target on the runway (which no one hit).


