Treasurers report was read and accepted as read.

Jody passed around photo's of Bob Andrew's planes that are still available.

John Good mentioned that HoodCanal Lions are hosting a veterans BBQ at the Hoodsport fire hall on Saturday November 14th. The lunch is free to veterans and their families.

Dick Robb gave an update on the swap meet - costs were \$1,125, net was \$2587 and our half was \$1,291. Attendance was down but tables were sold out.

Dick Robb motioned to buy two of Bob Andrew's planes for the Christmas raffle, A Revolver and a ParkZone SE 5, motion seconded and passed. Sylvia donated a .60 sized Corsair for the Scale Rally/qualifier raffle in May.

The price for the sandwich

machine we borrowed from the dive club is \$1000. We can write off \$300 a year in expenses to the Rotary for the next 3 years so the cost will end up being \$100, Stacy Myers motioned to purchase the machine, motion carried. We ended up with a total profit of \$1,671 from Oysterfest (after purchasing the sandwich machine)

The planes we bought about 6 months ago have all been sold. The club kept 1 trainer out of the batch for training and we made \$9 profit on the deal.

6 or 7 years ago we gave a scholarship to Breana Chavez, she has done quit well and her grandfather, Al Lester, was very happy we gave her the scholarship. He was an RC modeler in the past and recently had a stroke so he can no longer participate in the hobby. He donated most of his stuff to the club for use in the scholarship program. Jody sold a lot of it at the swap meet and brought in an additional \$539. At the end of the swap meet Lonnie Stuck also donated stuff to the club.

People at the meeting voted by secret ballot for the MVP award to be presented at the Christmas party.

The question of the ladies auxiliary was brought up. It was decided to use them for big events as

needed.

Dick Robb motioned to spend \$200 on a ladies door prize. All ladies to get a ticket upon entry at no cost. Motion carried.

Eric Oberg and Greg Yates have come up with a defibrillator for the club. After the firsts of the year they will schedule a class for CPR and defibrillator training purpose. The defibrillator is to be kept in the shed for emergencies.

Jody has been talking to Thom Martin about doing an ales event at Hunter farms. Dick Robb motioned to have an ales event after the haying is done. Motion carried.

Tom Strom Jr. said he would try to get a date in Aug for a two day pylon race. Preregistration to begin in January, if there are not enough entries by July it would be canceled. The winter 1/2 day pylon races will likely start in January and run for 3 months.

Dick Robb thanked all the club members who either helped set up or came to the swap meet, it really helped make it a club event.

Naming of the scholarship was brought up, it was decided to name next year's scholarship after Bob Andrew the next year after Al Lester and so on.
