Generate a self-created image

To do this, you will need a photo of your model or a photo of the corresponding original. The photo must Aspect ratio of 1.375:1 (side:height). To ensure that the photo blends harmoniously into the background of your channel's main screen, the background of the photo should be plain and solid white. If the original photo does not match the aspect ratio mentioned above, you must crop the photo using an image editing program. Then reduce this

photo to a pixel size of 110 x 80 pixels. In the image editing program, increase the color depth to 24 bits. This corresponds to 16 million colors (true colors). Now save this image as a BMP to your hard drive. If you have the option, save the photo with the RGB option. You can now copy this image to your channel.

Installing the image on your NX transmitter

Turn on the transmitter and connect it to your PC using a USB cable. To do this, go to SYSTEM SETTINGS and then to USB SETTINGS. Activate ACCESS INTERNAL STORAGE.

Now a new drive will appear on your PC. This is the internal memory of your transmitter. In the main directory of your transmitter memory, you must now create a new folder called Images . Copy the model photo



you created into this folder. Now exit the USB SETTINGS in your transmitter and go to the AIRCRAFT TYPE menu and then to the second screen (AIRCRAFT OPTIONS). At the end go to the menu item *Select Image and on the next screen select the entry Image from File. You will now see the image that you previously copied into the transmitter memory. Select this image, use the BACK button to exit all menus and go back to the main screen. Your created model image should now appear here.
